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**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE AWARD OF MERIT - CUM -
MEANS SCHOLARSHIPS FOR POST - GRADUATE COURSES
LEADING TO MASTER'S DEGREE AND P.G. DIPLOMA**

(1) **OBJECT** :-

In order that no meritorious student is denied opportunity for post - graduate studies for want of adequate means, the University has introduced a scheme for the award of post - graduate scholarship on the basis of the result of Bachelor's Degree Examination and financial circumstances of the students.

(2) **ALLOCATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS** :-

The scholarships available will be first distributed among the various Faculties These will be further distributed initially among the various subjects in a faculty provided that atleast one award shall always be made to each subject / single subject Faculty. If none of the students of any subject / Faculty finds a place in the merit-list of the allotted quota, the next eligible student of respective subject / Faculty may be considered for the award of the scholarship. Such awards are to be made from the quota allotted to the respective faculties.

(3) **COVERAGE AND ELIGIBILITY** :-

(1)

(i) Only those students who have obtained at least **First Class / Only "A" Grade** at the **Bachelor's / P.G's Degree Examination** in subject for which an allocation has been made and whose parents or guardian's annual income **from all sources** does not exceed **Rs.2,00,000/- after deduction of tax** will be eligible for the award of scholarship, subject to the fulfillment of other condition of the scheme.

(ii) Preference will be given to only girl child / BPL card holder.

(2) The Students who have passed Part - I or Part - II Examination of post - graduate studies, as the case may be, will also be eligible for the award of a fresh scholarship. The scholarship awarded to them in the first year of their studies will be continued subject to their Only for First Class / A Grade in the Part - I / II examination.

- (3) A student who is in full time employment, will not be eligible for the award of a scholarship. If however, he / she gives up employment or takes leave without pay for the purpose of further studies and commences his / her studies as full time student, he / she will be eligible for the award of a scholarship.
- (4) A scholarship holder shall not accept or hold any appointment, salaried or otherwise, and shall not receive any other scholarship, free studentship or stipend. In case, the scholar was in receipt of any such award or assistance he / she will have to forego that benefit in order to avail himself / herself of the benefit of the post – graduate scholarship.
- (5) A student studying in a part – time course or through a correspondence course will not be eligible for award.
- (6) The scholar shall not join any other course of studies or appear at any examination other than the examination for which the scholarship is awarded. In case, he / she appears at any other examination, his / her scholarship will be forfeited by him / her to the University.
- (7) The scholar will regularly attend the post – graduate lectures, actively participate in the tutorials, seminar discussions and other Programmes and carry out the assignments to the satisfaction of the post – graduate teachers concerned.
- (8) Part scholarship, supplementing the amount received by any scholar by way of Fellowship, etc. may be given to any scholar so that the total amount of the benefit from all source does not exceed the amount of full scholarship i.e. Rs. 5,000/- per annum.

(4) SELECTION AND PROCEDURE :

- (1) The syndicate will make the selection for the award of scholarships on the recommendation of a committee constituted for the purpose. The decision of the syndicate shall be final.
- (2) The eligible students will be selected strictly in order of merit and financial condition, starting from the top on the merit list of each subject / single subject Faculty, for which a quota of scholarship has been allocated under the scheme.
- (3) The Registrar will take steps for the award of scholarship as soon as the application are received from the students.
- (4) In case of equality of merit, the student holding a Bachelor's Degree from this University will be given preference.
- (5) In case, some students higher in rank, have not been selected for the award of scholarship, reason for not doing so shall be given in the remarks column.

- (6) As a token of PROVISIONAL SELECTION the Registrar will send each eligible students an undertaking form and a bill form of the scholarship through the Principal of the college / the Head of the University Department.

N.B.: It must be specifically noted that if the undertaking is not received from the student within the stipulated period. The scholarship will be awarded to the next student on the merit list and he / she cease to be entitled for the same.

- (7) The selected student shall submit the undertaking form, the bill form, the progress report etc., duly filled in through the Professor : incharge of the Centre and the Principal of the college concerned / the Head of the University Department. The Professor – incharge of the Centre and the Principal of the College concerned / the Head of University Department will complete the remaining portion of the said documents and forward them to the Registrar. The Registrar, on the receipt of the documents, will arrange to pay amount of scholarship, after scrutiny of the documents.

(5) VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP :

Subject to Rule 3 (8) each scholarship will be of the value of Rs. 5,000/- per annum. The payment of Scholarship shall be made at the end of the academic year and only after declaration of the result of Part-I or Part-II examination as the case may be and on the receipt of a satisfactory Annual Progress Report from the Professor – in – Charge of the Centre and the Principal of the College concerned / Head of the University Department. The Student who has not appeared or failed at the respective examination or has left the studies in the middle of the term / year shall not be entitled to receive the scholarship amount. The payment of scholarship will be made by the University Office at the appropriate time. No part payment of the Scholarship amount shall be made at the end of first term or in the middle of the academic year.

(6) DURATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP AND ITS RENEWAL :

- (1) The scholarship awarded on the result of the Bachelor's Degree examinations, may be renewed for the second year of the post – graduate course subject to the availability of funds and fulfilment of the conditions prescribed for continuing the award.
- (2) Renewal of a Scholarship under the Scheme will depend on promotion to the next class with A Grade for all subjects where grading system is inforce and atleast 60% marks where grading system is not in force at the University Examination for Part – I or Part – II of the Post – Graduate course as the case may be.

- (3) If a student shows unsatisfactory progress during the course of his / her studies or he / she gives up the chosen course of studies before its completion, or he / she changes the course of studies without the prior permission of the Registrar, the award of scholarship shall be cancelled. Good conduct and regularity in attendance are also essential conditions for continuance of the scholarship. The Scholarship once cancelled will not be restored under any circumstances. The decision of the Syndicate in this regard will be final and binding.
- (4) A Scholarship will be renewed for the next year, subject to the conditions stated above, and on the basis of marks obtained in the aggregate at Part – I or Part – II Examination and fulfilment of other conditions by the student. It will be in the interest of the student to fill in the form of application along with a certified copy of the relevant marksheet, as soon as the result to the Part – I / II Examination is declared and forwarded the same to the Registrar through the Professor – in – charge and the Principal of the College concerned / the Head of the University Department concerned, quoting the reference number of letter under which the award was initially communicated to him / her. This will enable the Registrar, to process the renewal of the Scholarship expeditiously. The Principal of the College / the Head of the University Department is expected to bring to the notice of the Registrar any adverse report on account of habitual and if necessary, to suggest cancellation of the scholarship award to the particular student.
- (5) In case the Principal of the College / the University Department gives adverse comments and specifically recommends in the annual progress report that the scholarship should not be renewed, the Registrar shall bring such a case to the notice of the Vice Chancellor before rejecting the application for renewal.
- (6) An attested copy of the marksheet of the Annual Examination should be attached to the form of application. This will enable the Registrar to decide the eligibility of the student regarding the renewal of the scholarship on the basis of the documentary evidence.

(7) PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP :

The Registrar, on receipt of the undertaking form, the bill form the progress report along with other documents shall draw the amount of scholarship for the first or the second instalment and arrange to pay the scholarship amount to the scholar as soon as possible.
